

HERITAGE CORE SUPPORT PROGRAM 2024 - 2025

WHO WE ARE:

Heritage Core Support Program is a homeschool support and enrichment program for families attending The Fathers House. The program consists of twice-per-week group sessions for grades 7-9 and 10-12 to complement the homeschooling each family is completing at home. Directors of the Heritage Core Support Program select the curriculum that will be used by the students in each group. The families and students will be expected to follow the schedule set by each tutor so that all students are ready to receive tutoring, complete projects and experiments, and discuss literature and writing as an in-sync group for maximum impact. Therefore, students are expected to attend every session throughout the school year (this is not a “drop in when you feel like it” program). Students will be expected to have completed specified lessons and preparation prior to coming to the core support sessions, as well as complete homework that follows or completes what is covered in sessions. Tutors will provide evaluations of student work and participation during sessions so parents can use this information to determine course grades for their homeschooling program.

Students should be registered in the appropriate classes based on previous year course completion or prerequisite completion. The Director of the Heritage Core Support Program can assist the parents with these placement choices.

All tutors present material and instruction with a Christian worldview, and the curriculum each group will be using will be written and presented with a Christian worldview. The curriculum for each student will be purchased using the enrollment fee paid for each student.

The Heritage Core Support Program will take place at The Fathers House—Vacaville Campus, 4800 Horse Creek Dr, Vacaville, CA 95688

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

As an expectation of participating in the Heritage Core Support Program, one parent from each family is asked to support the program by serving in various capacities during the times of operation. This parent will be expected to complete a background check at the family's expense, prior to the start date of the program.

Duties include:

- Morning arrival 7:30-9:30 supervision of front of building, bathroom break, and halls and classrooms of building
- Mid morning 9:30-11:00 hallway and departure supervision of front of building, bathroom break, and halls and classrooms of building
- Afternoon departure 11:00-1:00 supervision of front of building, bathroom break, and halls and classrooms of building
- Second adult in each classroom during classes
- Assistant to tutors to set up, assist, and clean up of science experiments.
- Other duties still TBD

FEES & TUITION:

ENROLLMENT FEE:

Varies per student following the "Build your registration" on the student application, one check per family. Staple your check to the application packet and submit no later than May 8, 2024. Enrollment fees are applied to books and supplies for the year and are non-refundable once your child is enrolled. Once application documents have been reviewed, a family interview will be scheduled. After the interview, if all parties agree and we have space in the program, we will enroll your student.

Heritage Core Support Program will run mid-August, 2024 to June 5, 2025. Your agreement to enroll indicates you are making a ten-month (August to May) financial commitment and secures a spot in our program, regardless of whether you choose to complete the Heritage Core Support school year.

First Monthly Tuition Payment due by first day of class in August, 2024

Monthly tuition payments due the first of each month, September 2024 – May 2025

Late fee: \$25 per student if tuition payment is not received by the 7th of the month.

The leadership committee of Heritage Homeschool Support reviews all applications and schedules an informal meeting with new families to determine if Heritage Core Support Program is a good fit for all parties. We prayerfully consider the enrollment and placement of students. After your interview, we notify you whether we can move forward with enrollment or return the enrollment fees, if not.
